

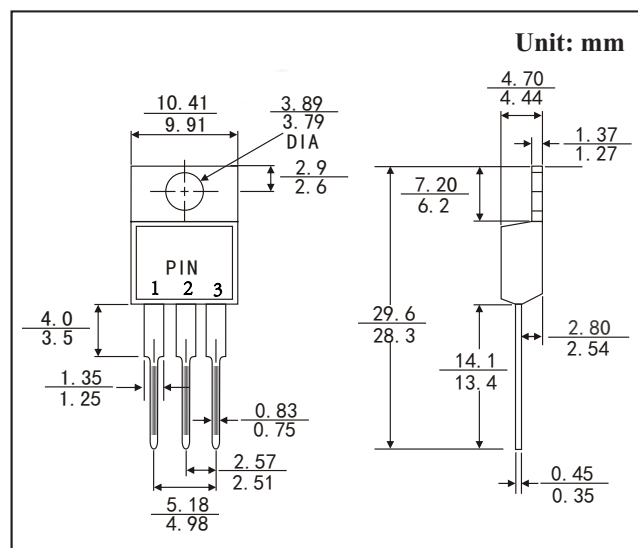

FIG1: I_o - T_c Curve

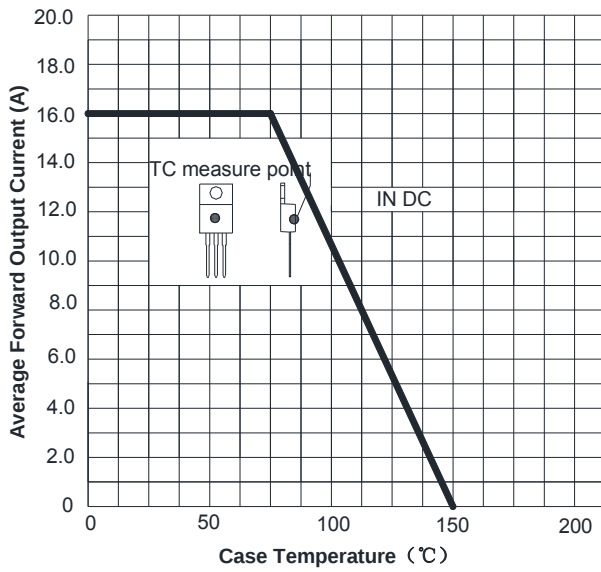


FIG2: Surge Forward Current Capability

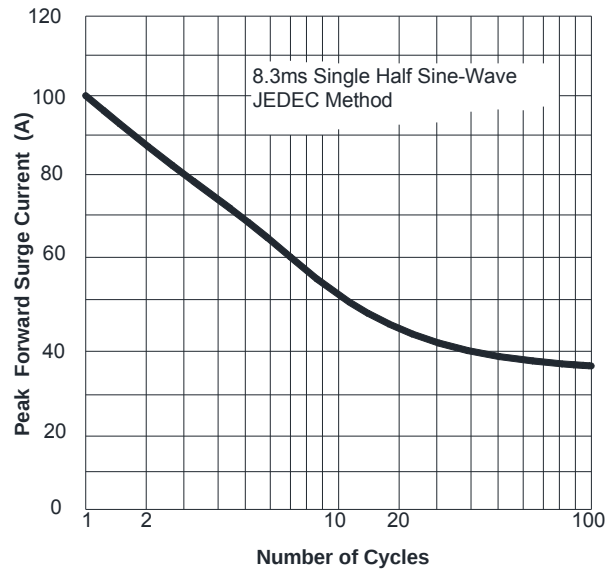


FIG3: Forward Voltage

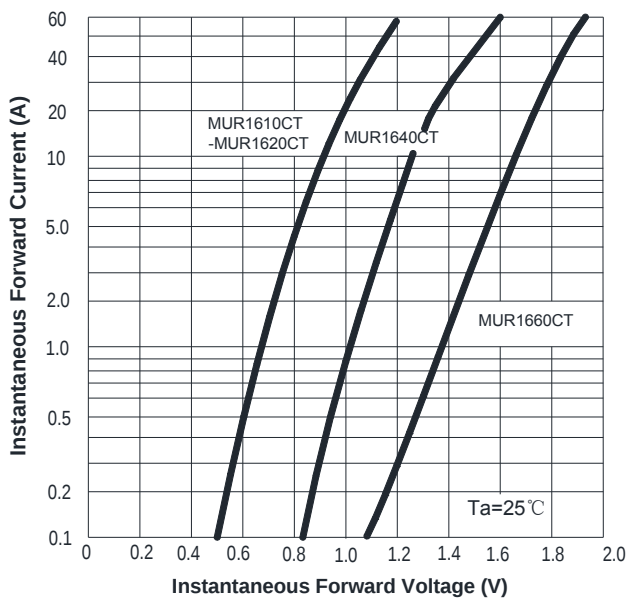


FIG4: Typical Reverse Characteristics

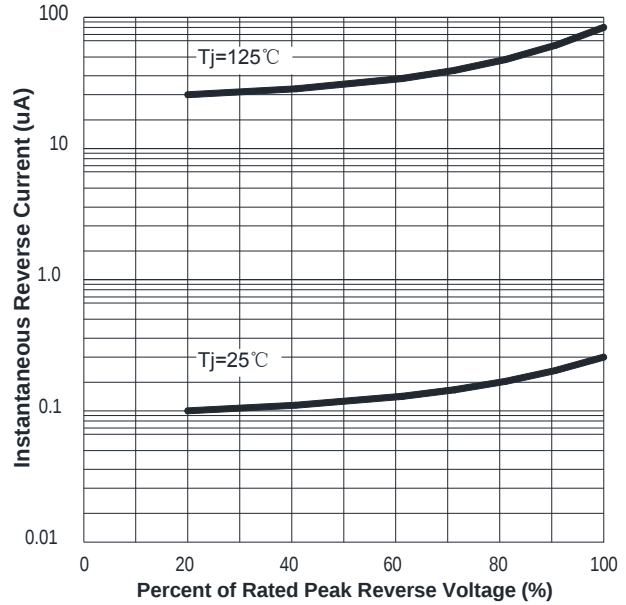


FIG.5 Diagram of circuit and Testing wave form of reverse recovery time
